Bishop Holley and Sister Janet will also share from their own personal experience of spiritual direction and their spiritual journey.

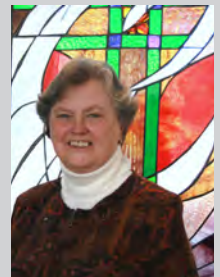

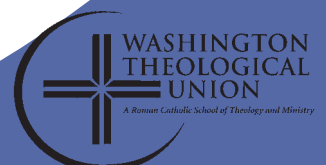
